Phase One Tennis Rules and Procedures

- It is required that all the rules and regulations listed out in this procedure be followed without any exceptions. If a member or guest is found to not be following these rules and procedures, they will be politely asked to leave the facility.
- All rules and procedures are subject to change and will be in accordance with the guidelines provided by the CDC and will follow all local and state mandates.
- We recommend that if you are a vulnerable individual to COVID 19 that you do not play during Phase One.
- For your safety and the safety of others you will not be permitted to play if you:
 - Are exhibiting any symptoms of the coronavirus: mild to severe respiratory illness with fever, cough and difficulty breathing, or other symptoms identified by the CDC.
 - Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Players are permitted to arrive 10 mins prior to play and asked to leave immediately after their court reservation. You will not be able to congregate in the common areas at the Tennis Center during Phase One.
- The Pro Shop will remain closed during Phase One. Restrooms will be open during Phase One but we ask you to be mindful of others and practice social distancing when it comes to the number of people in the restrooms at one time.
- Social play will be permitted during Phase one and we ask that you read and follow the COVID -19 playing tennis safely guidelines and the #Safe tennis guidelines and adhere to them as the conditions of play. **Guidelines are posted both on court and on the Arrowhead Homeowners website: arrowheadatvail.net**
- Private lessons of up to 3 people will be available once the Cliff Drysdale tennis professionals are onsite, approximately late May. If you would like to book a lesson, please contact the pro directly. All members taking a private lesson must adhere to the rules and directions that the pro provides.
- All payments for lessons will be online. Your pro will provide instructions
- All players and lessons are required to practice social distancing at all times.
- Play is assumed to be at your own risk.
