



# ARROWHEAD AT VAIL

Dear Arrowhead at Vail Homeowner,

Safety is one of the key points in The Arrowhead at Vail Mission Statement. The AVA board is committed to ensuring that safety is an ongoing priority, especially for our residents, and their guests and invitees, no matter what Arrowhead amenity they choose to enjoy. As our community and the surrounding Vail Valley returns to the outdoors, we have experienced an increase in activity in Arrowhead from bicyclists, runners, pedestrians and hikers. In order to ensure the safest environment for all, the Board proposes the implementation of Rules and Regulations for cyclists and pedestrians.

The Rules and Regulations have been developed to clearly communicate the safe behaviors that are required for all who use the variety of trails, paths and roadways that are found in our neighborhood and on Arrowhead Mountain. This includes particularly Cresta Road with its steep and narrow roadway and sharp switchbacks. The Rules and Regulations will be communicated several ways. A cyclist code and a pedestrian/hiker/snowshoe code have been developed. These codes will be posted at various locations in the neighborhood. Copies will be given to biking and hiking guests as they enter the main Public Safety gate. The codes will also be printed on the new Arrowhead maps. Copies of both codes are attached for your information. The Board continues to discuss the concept of a Bike Registration program, similar to other valley communities.

Consistent with past practice, we are providing you with the enclosed Arrowhead Cyclist and Pedestrian Rules and Regulations for comment during a 30-day period. The AVA Board of Directors as well as the Arrowhead Metro District Board worked together on this plan and both have endorsed it. The AVA Board will review all comments submitted prior to adoption of a Resolution which will occur at its meeting on August 24, 2020.
