## Current Health Concerns

The AVA and Metro District Boards have been in regular contact with Vail Resorts and each other regarding the health and safety of our homeowners and community. With the shutdown of our Mountain, the numbers of people coming into the neighborhood is greatly reduced. Note that this shutdown includes both Arrowhead residents and non-residents and includes uphill traffic like skinning and snow shoeing and all trails.
